Through water supply

Can be added to drinking water via dispenser. Administer daily at rates not exceeding the following: For cattle administer 0.1 to 1.2 mL per animal per day. For sheep administer 10 to 45 mL per 1000 animals per day*.

Oral drenching

Administer orally at rates not exceeding the following: 3 to 6 mL per sheep can be administered at 8 weeks and again at 4 weeks prior to lambing.

Foliar application

Pasture spray: 1.5 litres per hectare, wait 3 to 7 days pre-grazing. Spray every 6 weeks.

Brassica feed crops: 3 litres per hectare, wait 3 to 7 days pre-grazing. One spray should be sufficient.

Supplementary feed

Apply to supplementary feed daily at rates not exceeding the following:

For cattle apply 0.1 to 1.2 mL per animal per day. For sheep apply 10 to 45 mL per 1000 animal per day*.

*Use the higher levels when on brassica feed. Key times of supplementation include the last 6 to 8 weeks of pregnancy when the foetal thyroid glands are being formed.

STORAGE

Keep container closed.

Store in a cool place out of direct sunlight.
