PRODUCT INFORMATION: Myco-RF^Ihas both contact and systematic action. It is absorbed by the leaves and stems and transported in an upwards and outwards movement in the plant, which provides protection into new growth. Full coverage is therefore necessary as plant parts below the area of contact will not be protected. It is an offence to use this product on animals.

COMPATIBILITY: Myco-RF® is compatible with most commonly used herbicides and insecticides. Myco-RF® should be used in conjunction with Donaghys Mycowet® Surfactant.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Recommended use rate: Apply 236g Myco-RF® per hectare

Mixing: Each 1kg pack is sufficient to treat 4.2 hectares of pasture. Open foil pack and remove inner pack which is soluble in water. Add unopened inner pack to partly filled spray tank with aditation running and then top up with water.

Rainfall: Do not apply if rain is likely within 1 hour of application. If 15mm or more of rain occurs within 3 hours of treatment, then pasture should be resprayed.

PASTURE TREATMENT FOR RUST AND FUSARIUM SPP

Boom Spraying: Apply 236g Myco-RF[®] plus 100ml Donaghys Mycowet[®] Surfactant in 100 litres of water per hectare. Increase Mycowet[®] to 150ml per hectare with water rates of 101-150 litres per hectare and to 200ml per hectare with water rates or 151-200 litres per hectare.

Aerial Spraying: Apply 23g Myco-AF^P plus 100m I Donaphys Mycowet[®] Surfactant in 50 litres of water per hectare. Apply at first sign of rust development and Fusarium spp. A further application may be necessary later if climatic conditions favour re-infection. Ensure complete coverage of all areas likely to be grazed. Spray should not be applied when air temperature exceeds 20° Co rwind velocity exceeds 12kh.

RYEGRASS SEED CROPS

Crown Rust, Stem Rust: Apply 236g Myco-RF[®] plus 100ml Donaghys Mycowet[®] Surfactant in a minimum of 200 litres water/ha at the first appearance of the disease. A further application may be necessary 4 weeks later if disease pressure remains high or re-infection occurs.

Blind Seed Disease: Apply the above rates and make the first application at start of flowering and a second 10-14 days later.

NOTE: Do not apply Myco-RF* to the same pasture area or crop at less than 28 day intervals or more than two times per season.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD

Ryegrass Seed Crops: 30 days.

Pasture: Animals may be reintroduced into pasture treated with Myco-RP[®] 10 days after application. Animals for slaughter must be placed on a clean pasture for 6 days prior to slaughter. Pasture is considered clean from residues 45 days after treatment. When pasture cannot be guaranteed clean such as in aerial applications animals must not be sent for slaughter for 51 days after treatment of the pasture.
