



# **Donaghys ProMonensin 60**

Donaghys ProMonensin 60 is a scientifically formulated liquid containing Sodium Monensin - an ionophore known to provide a range of advantages if administered to dairy cows, including aiding the treatment and prevention of ketosis and bloat.

#### **BENEFITS:**

Donaghys ProMonensin 60 can be administered year round to dairy cows.

- For increased production of milk solids in pasture fed dairy cows
- · Reduces gas to aid in the control of bloat
- Aids in the control of ketosis

Donaghys ProMonensin 60 is an organic solvent based formulation which has a lower viscosity than other water based formulations; providing easier mixing and handling for pouring and administering.

# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Donaghys ProMonensin 60 is suitable for use with metered inline water dispenser systems.

After dilution, it is also suitable for oral drenching and can be pre-mixed with liquid vitamins or mineral supplement concentrates.

(It is not recommended for use in non-metered or individual trough dispenser systems).

This product must not be used in ruminants for the purposes of growth promotion in ruminants intended for human consumption.

# **CAUTION:**

**DO NOT** use on dogs or horses as fatal toxicosis may result. Prevent access of medicated water to horses or dogs.

Ensure recommended doses are not exceeded. Do not use concurrently with other Sodium Monensin products. Do not treat cattle with products containing erythromycin, tiamulin or oleandomycin while using Donaghys ProMonensin 60.







## **DOSE RATES:**

Dosage is for therapeutic use only.

Dairy Cows: 5mL / Head / Day\* (year round)

Donaghys ProMonensin 60 can also be administered to replacement heifers and beef cattle at the rate of 5mL/head/day (year round).
