EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 764 766

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away and warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. Call the emergency services: Dial 111
Spill or Leak	Wear suitable protective clothing. Restrict access to contaminated area. Contain the spill and prevent further dispersion. Retrieve intact containers from site. Place damaged containers into containment devices. Absorb spills with inert material (e.g. sand or vermiculite), and place in waste containers. Wash the area with water and absorb with further inert material. Collect spilled material and place in sealable containers for subsequent disposal. Prevent contamination of water courses or sewers. Dispose of waste safely. If greater than 100L is stored in one location, secondary containment and emergency plans to manage any potential spills must be in place. In all cases design storage to prevent discharge to stormwater drains. (If this occurs contact your regional council immediately).
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:	If swallowed seek medical attention. Do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
If in Eyes:	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. Get medical advice/attention.
If on Skin:	Wash with plenty of soap and water. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention. Wash contaminated clothing before use.
If Inhaled:	If breathing is difficult, remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If experiencing respiratory symptoms, call the POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician.

STORAGE AND SEGREGATION SUMMARY

Storage: Store locked up below 25°C, in original container. Keep in a well-ventilated place and protect from light. Store away from foodstuffs, children and animals. Keep container sealed when not in use.

Aggregate Storage Volume Thresholds: When stored with substances of the same hazard the aggregate quantity must be considered. For full details refer to the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals and the HSNO Regulations.
